Summary

US Market:

- Apparel store sales in 2020 were reported US\$ 130 bn., which is approx. 32% less than 2019. The store sales were record low in Mar-May period after which it started recovering. In Sep and Oct the recovery was good, but again in Nov and Dec. the sales fell sharply.
- Home Furnishings store sales fared a bit better with sales in first 10-months of 2020 only 10% lower than in same period in 2019.
- The US apparel imports are recovering steadily after hitting lowest in May 2020. Jan. to Nov. 2020 apparel imports stand at US\$ 59 bn., approx. 24% less than same period last year.
- China has lost approx. 7% share in the US apparel imports which has mainly been taken up by Vietnam, Bangladesh and Cambodia

EU Market:

- EU-27 apparel imports are recovering steadily since Jun. 2020. but showed a decline in October due the second wave of Covid19 in EU. Jan. to Oct. 2020 apparel imports were € 58.4 bn., approx. 14% less than same period last year.
- China's share in EU apparel imports increased by 1% during Jan to Oct. 2020. The main losers were Bangladesh, India and Cambodia.



Monthly Apparel Store Sales





Monthly Home Furnishings Store Sales





Monthly Apparel Import Update





by Vietnam, Bangladesh and Cambodia




